- Pickups from customers
- Storage at the distribution center / Bulk pick ups every Wednesday
- Furniture Donations 35 Bulk loads in 2013

HISTORY - WHAT TYPES OF SURPLUS?

- Corporate, Government: Private Office, Systems, Reception, Conference
- Education: Classroom, Administrative, Residential, Athletic, Science/Lab
- Healthcare: Patient Room, Exam Room,
 Administrative, Equipment, Supplies
- Other: Kitchen/Cafeteria, Library, Lab, Casework, Doors, Windows



HISTORY - FOR REAL?

- More than 1,600 Projects
- Over 400 Clients in 27 States
- More than 50 Million Pounds
 Diverted from Landfill
- Project Size: 4-5 Desks to 34-35
 Tractor Trailers
- Surplus Sent to 51 Countries and 24 U.S. States

Pre Project

- Clear and accurate inventory
- Photo documentation
- GIK value assessment

Logistics

- Understanding the project site
- Understanding the recipients needs and requirements
- Setting up cost effective transportation

Follow up

- Reporting
- Certificates
- Data
